



I have been thinking about having Solar Photovoltaic panels fitted for some time, as we have had the panels for the heating of water for 6 years, and as the electric costs keep rising I decided to go ahead. I received a mailshot from Affordable Solar Energy, I gave them a call, and the sales rep came and explained the system, so I placed the order, there was a delay in the installation, but this was because of the shortage of inverters. The panels were fitted and commissioned on the 4th May, they have been operating for 10 days, at the moments the meter is showing a input of 75 kilowatt's, and at times during the day the electricity meter is going in reverse, which means the electric we are using is coming from the panels. That is with a plasma television on, also a computer. So there will be a difference in the electric bills.
